${\bf Special\ Provision}(s)$

1. Coconut Development Fund and Coconut Consumers Stabilization Fund. In addition to the amounts appropriated herein, Seventy Million Four Hundred Thousand Pesos (P70,400,000) shall be used for the development of the coconut industry sourced from service fees on desiccated coconut and from levies on copra rececada, constituted into the Coconut Development Fund and Coconut Consumers Stabilization Fund in accordance with Section 14 of R.A. No. 1145 and Section 1, Article III of P.D. No. 1468, respectively.

Implementation of this provision shall be subject to judicious programming based on actual collections and utilization of funds.

GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT, FY 2025

Release of funds shall be subject to the submission of a Special Budget Request, and other relevant budgetary requirements in accordance with applicable laws, rules, and regulations.

The Philippine Coconut Authority (PCA) shall monitor and evaluate the progress of the programs, activities and projects relative to the use of the fund and submit a written quarterly progress report thereon, which shall be submitted to the Congressional Oversight Committee on Agricultural and Fisheries Modernization (COCAFM), the House Committee on Appropriations, and the Senate Committee on Finance.

2. Subsidy to the Philippine Coconut Authority. The amount of One Billion Two Hundred Nine Million Nine Hundred Ninety Seven Thousand Pesos (P1,209,997,000) appropriated herein under subsidy for the Philippine Coconut Authority (PCA) shall be used for the implementation of the Coconut and Oil Palm Industry Development Program.

In the implementation of said projects, the PCA shall give priority to major coconut producing provinces and other provinces identified in the Focus Geographical Areas in accordance with National Budget Memorandum No. 126 dated April 4, 2016.

3. Special Provisions Applicable to All Government Corporations. In addition to the foregoing special provisions, the special provisions applicable to all government corporations enumerated under the Budgetary Support to Government Corporations-Others shall be observed by the PCA.
